- Economics: macroeconomics in the world economy: theory and applications- 3 credit hours

Determinants of the level of economic activity, inflation, unemployment, international economics, impact of domestic and world economy on business decisions, applications of the theory. Prerequisites: Economics 120 and Economics 121; and Math 121.

Political Science

- Political Science Introduction to Comparative Politics – 3 credit hours

Comparative study of political institutions, political culture, and political processes and selected major countries of the world.

- Political Science Introduction to international Relations --3 credit hours

Political, military, and economic relations between states, international organizations and transnational actors. Problems of war, imperialism and the world economy. Prospects for global cooperation.
